- **Tracking**: Keep track of responses to ensure comprehensive data collection.

4. Feedback Analysis

- **Threshold for Action**: Consider the benchmark for taking action based on the percentage of responses indicating 'Excellent', 60% or fewer.
- **Identifying Concerns**: Analyze feedback to identify areas of concern by comparing responses against established benchmarks.
- Narrative Responses: Pay special attention to responses in the open-ended question section to identify any serious concerns not covered by the multiple-choice questions.

5. Action Recommendation

Recommendation: Based on the analysis, recommend actions for addressing key concerns identified in the feedback.




