

CONSULTANCY AGREEMENT

3. Consultancy Fee and Expenses

(a) Consultancy Fee. In consideration of the Services to be rendered hereunder, the Company shall pay Consultant a Consultancy fee for each Services provided to the Company

(b) Expenses. Consultant shall be entitled to reimbursement for all pre-approved expenses reasonably incurred in the performance of the Services, upon submission and approval of written statements and receipts in accordance with the then regular procedures of the Company.

RBVRR shall provide all the relevant documentation to **New life** regarding the formulation and development and Vice versa

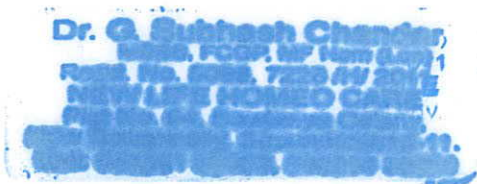
