WORLD TB DAY
24 March is celebrated as "World Tuberculosis Day" because on this date in 1882 Dr. Robert Koch announced that he had discovered the bacterium that causes TB. Tuberculosis is a highly contagious disease and serious infection spread by *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* which mainly attacks the lungs. It is responsible for highest numbers of death and soon will surpass the death caused by HIV.

Because of the limitations of current TB tests, it is even more difficult to diagnose TB in HIV positive individuals, than to diagnose TB in people without HIV infection. Many people with HIV will have a false negative result from a TB sputum smear test. This can result in a large number of cases of active TB disease going undiagnosed. By contrast the diagnosis of HIV in people with TB should always be straightforward because of the availability of quick and cheap point-of-care diagnostics for HIV infection. Globally in 2018, 64% of medical TB patients had a documented HIV test. This was an increase from 46% in 2017. The risk of developing tuberculosis (TB) is estimated to be between 16-27 times greater in people living with HIV than among those without HIV infection.

NOVEL THERAPEUTIC APPROACHES FOR TB TREATMENT:
In the last decade, a range of new treatment options have emerged. Evaluation of these is ongoing through an expanding portfolio of pre-clinical research and clinical trials.

- The increased number of drug resistant (MDR/XDR) strains and the failure of the conventional regimens against these strains are the challenges of the coming decades.
- The goals of new therapeutic approaches are to ensure cure without relapse, to inhibit death, contagion and the formation of drug resistant strains.
- The main approaches of anti-tubercular therapy involve either development of new chemical entity with a novel mechanism of action or repositioning of old drugs which show significant activity on drug resistant strains. Repositioning existing drugs is a promising alternative to the expensive and time-consuming process of drug discovery.
- A number of carrier-based drug delivery systems incorporating the principal anti-tubercular drug has been developed to provide targeted action with reduced dosing frequency in order to improve the patient compliance which is a major reason for therapeutic treatment failure.
- The recent approaches to the treatment of tuberculosis in terms of discovery of new chemical entity, repositioning of old drugs and the use of novel drug delivery technology for complete eradication of *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* such as:
 1. LIPOSOMES
 2. NIOSOMES
 3. LIPID CRYSTALS
 4. SOLID LIPID NANOPARTICLES
 5. POLYMERIC MICELLES
 6. DENDRIMERS
 7. NANOMIMETIC LIPID
 8. NANOSPONGES
 9. SILICANANANOPARTICLES
 10. POLYMERIC NANOPARTICLES
 11. MICROPARTICLES

There are justifiable grounds for optimism that recent advances in TB drug development will result in achievement of some priority goals in the management of active TB. The recent licensing of Bedaquiline and the encouraging performance of sterilizing drugs such as the 4-methoxyfluorquinolones and Nitroimidazole in Phase III clinical trials are concrete signs of progress towards shorter therapy. The precise role of new drugs in the management of MDR-TB remains undefined and Phase III clinical trials will not report for several years.

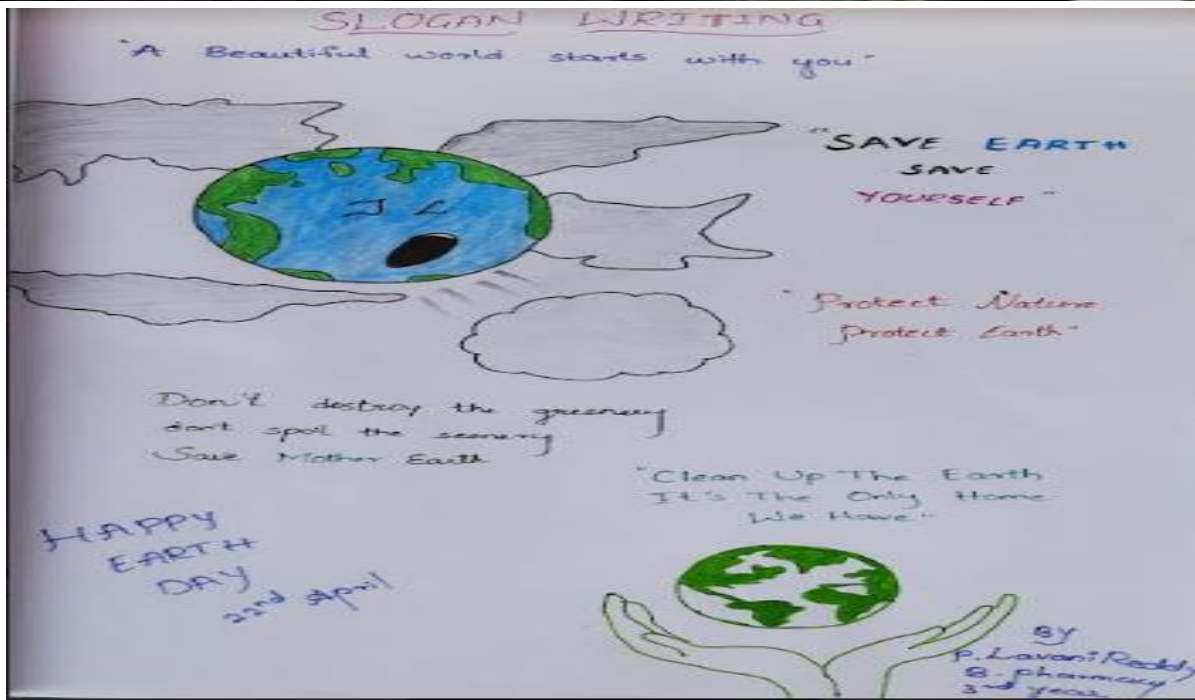

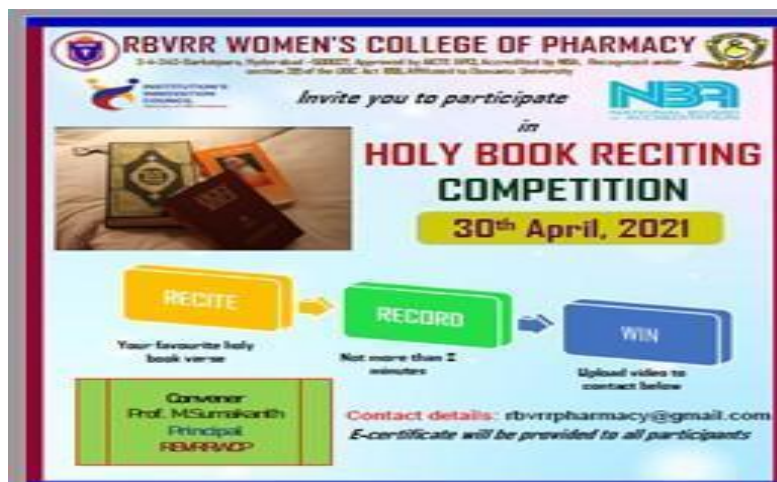
