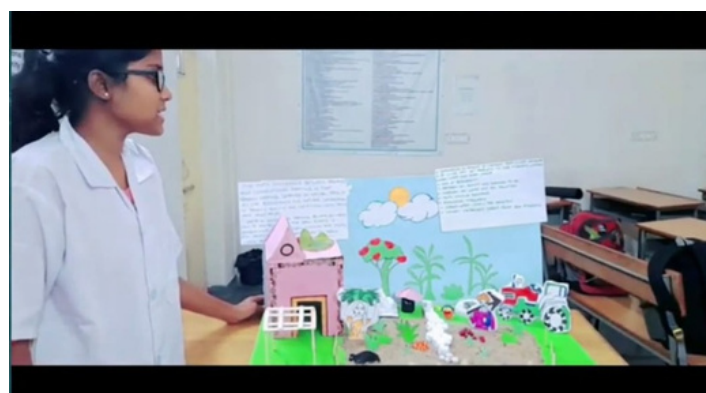
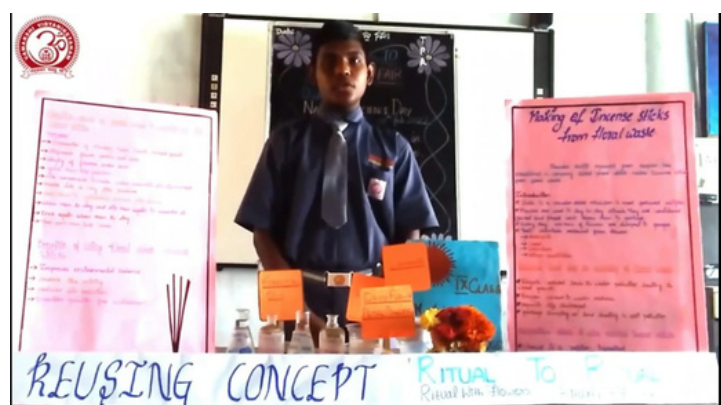
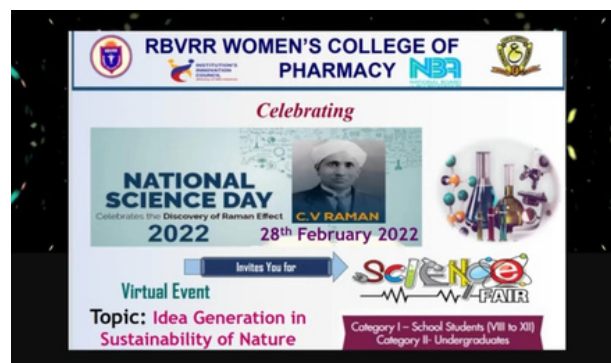
Webinar - Intellectual Property Rights
